- VII. AUTOMATIC subsidy assistance for all Veterans, active and retired. (Tuition \$40/day and below) Priority until age 4.
- VIII. FREE \_\_\_\_\_ for widows and single parents?
- IX. FREE Date night care for current licensed foster parents!!! One per Month (For their bio and foster kids) \$360/month total.
- X. FREE Posted baby items, diapers/wipes on FB site weekly/monthly for providers and parents.
- XI. FREE digital curriculum for FB site. (Designed in-house)
- XII. Foundation funding to other non-profits when needed.
